Both Law and Gospel are found in both the Old and New Testaments and both are given to us by God so we understand the problem of our sin (LAW) and our need for Jesus and His forgiveness (GOSPEL).

SAMPLE LAW STATEMENTS/VERSES

1. Remember, the Law helps control sin (curb), shows us our sin (mirror), and shows us how to live a God-pleasing life (guide).
2. “The soul who sins shall die.” **Ezekiel 18:4**
3. “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” **Romans 3:23**
4. Any of the 10 Commandments (Do not lie, murder, covet, commit adultery, worship other gods, misuse God’s name, steal, etc.)
5. Is used by the Holy Spirit to show us our sins and move us to be sorry because of them.
6. The Law is a series of commands, of do’s and don’ts.

SAMPLE GOSPEL STATEMENTS/VERSES

1. “For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.” **John 3:16**
2. “For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last He will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God, whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another.” **Job 19:25-27**
3. Provides the power for living the Christian life.
4. Includes only promises and words of comfort.
5. Should be shared with those who know their sin and struggle under its burden.
6. “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost.” **Luke 19:10**
