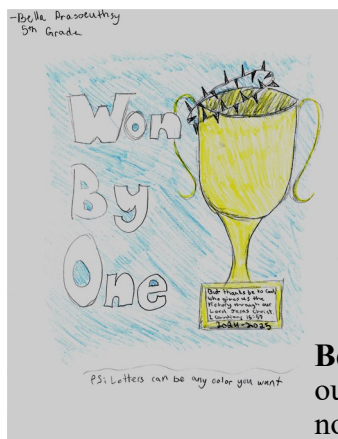


We welcome **Pastor Peter Williamson** and his family as our new Associate Pastor.
