

2020-2021 Confirmation Requirements

- 1. Pray, read Scripture, and serve:** do all regularly as God intends for your blessing.
- 2. Faithfully attend worship for the hearing of God's Word and to receive the Sacrament.** Trinity will be your primary place of worship. However, if you are out of town and attend at another church, turn in a copy of that church's worship folder/bulletin to your teacher or place in the "Confirmation In" box in the church hallway, near the Pastors' offices. If you need help in finding a LCMS church in the town you will be visiting please contact Mr. Stengl.
- 3. Complete 20 sermon reports** by May 5th, 2021. Sermon reports are to be signed by student and parent and turned in to your teacher in class or placed in the "Confirmation In" box in the church hallway, near the Pastors' offices. Sermon reports from churches that are not in fellowship with the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod will not be accepted.
- *4. Acolyte as scheduled throughout the year.** If you cannot acolyte when you are scheduled you must find a substitute and notify the church office by Wednesday at 4pm of the week you are scheduled. Your name is printed in the bulletin and needs to be changed. (*this can count as one of your vocational services in the church, but only if you show up!*) Sign-ups are done online and an invite will be emailed out to each family each quarter.
- *5. Attend Jr. High YAT (Youth Group) 6 times during the year** (*this can count as one of your vocational services in the church, but only if you show up!*). Jr. High YAT meets from 6:00-8:00 on the 1st & 3rd Sunday of each month. Youth group is about Christian friendships, genuine community, and true difference-making. Why youth group? It's a place where you can be with friends, serve others, and continue to hear again the faith purely taught and confessed according to Holy Scripture and the Lutheran Confessions and where we will seek to prepare you for marriage, life away from home and life as an adult.
- 6. Show 9 specific examples of service in your various vocations throughout the year.** Keep track on forms provided and, when possible, attach supporting documentation for each example. You must have at least 3 examples for each estate (family, society, church). Turn in completed forms to your teacher in class or place in the "Confirmation In" box in the church hallway, near the Pastors' offices by May 5th, 2021.
- 7. Complete assigned work fully and on time,** complete and turn in any memory work, homework, comply with the expectations and rules of your teacher and classroom, and show your teacher and other students respect and honor.

These requirements are firm and in order to be confirmed at the completion of 8th grade all requirements need to be met. To be sure students are on track we will be asking that students and parents meet with our Pastors and DCE at mid-year to assess where they are at.
