SECURITY DOORS PROJECT The second set of security doors will begin installation next week. This project will combine the proceeds from Legacy 2019 and Legacy 2021 to enhance security measures at Trinity, particularly during church events where the elevator and upstairs restrooms need to be accessible. Moving forward, the school and childcare will continue to be completely secure during these events, which has been a challenge in previous years. A second set of doors will be installed in the 1st floor hallway after the elevators, and in the 2nd floor hallway after the restrooms. The existing doors will stay where they are because they are fire doors. Both sets of doors will be badge coded and looped into the security system.
