Welcome back families! I have missed you and hearing your children play and laugh here at Trinity. I ask for your patience as we transition back into childcare. The new guidelines that are in place will take some time for us all to adjust to. These have been put in place to keep everyone safe that comes into Trinity. Please remember to have your security badge with you at all times, as the front doors are locked from 6:30-7:00 am and then again starting at noon. Your security badges are programmed to unlock the outside main doors so you are able to get into the building. The scanner is on the railing to the right of the main doors. Your security badge will work on the inside security doors same as before. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask.

With the warmer weather, finally here we need to talk about some summer information.

- ❖ Please bring in unexpired labeled sunscreen for your child. Your child's teacher will have a form for you to fill out. If you would like to bring bug spray in for your child, you can fill out the same form as the sunscreen.
- ❖ Check your child's extra clothes supply as when we closed it was still cold outside. I am sure your child has probably grown some and would prefer not to wear long sleeves during the summer.
- ❖ For summer footwear, we ask that all sandals have a back. You can leave a pair of tennis shoes here in your child's cubby if you prefer.
- ❖ Cold lunches are required. You will need to include an ice pack if needed to keep things cold, any utensils needed and a drink.
- ❖ Have a labeled water bottle as we are not utilizing the drinking fountains.
