THE RITE OF CONFIRMATION for our Jr. Confirmands will happen on Sunday, October 30th during the 9:00 Divine Service. Our students' Capstone Projects will also be on display in the lounge that morning. In September we had our annual Confirmation Retreat where time was spent reviewing all that had been learned about the Christian faith over the past years as well as a time of examination. Confirmation is a custom of the Church and not a sacrament. It links the catechumens to their Baptism, celebrates the hearing of the Lord's Word among them and affirms their continued reception to the Lord's Table. Confirmation declares of a catechumen that he or she is a Christian who has been baptized, confesses the faith, and is in communion with Christ and His Church. Confirmation assumes that ongoing catechesis is the way of life for the faithful Christian. This rite emphasizes God's work in Baptism, the gift of faith, and the benefits of the Lord's Supper for all who believe in Christ and the words of His testament. Our congregational family is asked to be vigilant in prayer for these students that God would continue to keep them in the one true faith and that they would continue to be faithful in attending the Divine Service where God's gifts of forgiveness, life and salvation are freely given through His Word and Sacraments.
