REGULAR OFFICE HOURS are 7:30am-4pm Mon-Fri. Scrip will be sold 7:30am-3:30pm. Door #1 (the main door) will be open during those hours to allow for SCRIP sales and office staff access. Anything outside of those hours will need to be scheduled through the church and school offices. Childcare families will need their badges all day every day to access the secure areas.

SUNDAY SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: Volunteer substitute teachers and substitute classroom assistants are needed to keep the Sunday School program running effectively. (Please see descriptions of the two volunteer substitute positions below.) Currently, we have just enough teachers to cover the three classrooms with no substitute teachers available. If you have a passion for sharing the love of Jesus with children, pray about becoming a Sunday School teacher or classroom assistant!

Both substitute positions would only be called if the regular teacher/assistant is unavailable. **Substitute teachers** would be responsible for reading through the provided lesson plan and facilitating the pre-planned classroom activity. **Substitute classroom assistants** would be responsible for assisting with the pre-planned classroom activities, games, and crafts, in which all of the materials are provided beforehand in the classroom. Both substitute positions would require background checks, short video training, and reading of a 9-page Sunday School policy manual.
