Dear Alumni & Friends of Trinity Lutheran School,

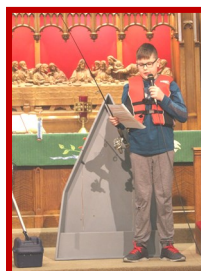

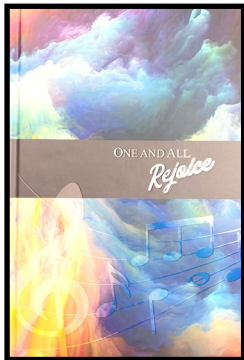

Childcare Director

The Trinity Childcare has been part of Trinity for about 30 years. It has seen its changes over the years. One thing has remained and that is teaching the children who attend about the love of Jesus. The childcare has families with varying Christian backgrounds that range from being members of Trinity to having no church home. A majority of the children from childcare go into the 4K program. This last school year we had one child graduate 8th grade that started in the childcare as a baby. The childcare is currently running at a 50% staff shortage. This has drastically reduced the number of children we can have enrolled in the program and has made it difficult to meet budget. The childcare is currently running at a deficit and looking for support to get through this challenging time. We pray that the economy continues to improve and people return to the workforce. We will continue to have faith in our Lord and Savior as we navigate through these earthly challenges.
