**PROPERTIES UPDATE** After evaluation, the Properties Committee has determined that our major 3-year facility priorities\* are:

- 1) Interior Sanctuary repair *over the balcony only*: est. \$25,000; Priority level = Critical (to prevent damage to organ pipes)
- 2) Exterior brick/woodwork *restoration:* est. \$80,000; Priority level = Critical (to prevent future interior damage)
- 3) All remaining repair to ceiling and walls in interior Sanctuary: est. \$55,000; Priority level = High (to prevent future cracks/flaking)
- 4) Carpet replacement (Sanctuary, Narthex, Lounge): est. \$50,000; Priority level = High (to prevent tripping) Keep in mind that any estimates here may change with time and materials.
- \*Please look for the Church Admin article in the April newsletter for more detail.

Please be aware that there is an ORANGE CONE in the NORTH parking lot near the digital sign which marks a spot in the parking lot where the pavement is broken and has formed a sizable bump. We are unable to fix this until the ground thaws, but we are aware of it and will address it as soon as possible. Please avoid this potential hazard when walking or driving.
