PROPERTIES UPDATE After evaluation this week, Properties Committee has determined that our major 3-yr facility priorities* are:

1) Interior Sanctuary repair *over the balcony only*: est. \$25,000; Priority level = Critical (to prevent damage to organ pipes)

2) Exterior brick/woodwork *restoration:* est. \$80,000; Priority level = Critical (to prevent future interior damage)

3) All remaining repair to ceiling and walls in interior Sanctuary: est. \$55,000; Priority level = High (to prevent future cracks/flaking) 4) Carpet replacement (Sanctuary, Narthex, Lounge): est. \$50,000; Priority level = High (to prevent tripping) Keep in mind that any estimates here may change with time and materials.
