## SAMPLE LAW STATEMENTS/VERSES

- 1. Remember, the Law helps control sin (curb), shows us our sin (mirror), and shows us how to live a God-pleasing life (guide).

- 3. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23
