ALTAR GUILD is looking for individuals to join us in being servants to our congregation at Trinity. Commitment is usually one service per month, 4 meetings per year, and a yearly cleaning of our Altar and Chancel areas. There is no length of commitment—it is how long you desire or can serve. It consists of a small amount of time prior to and after the service. If you need to have more flexibility during the week, the Altar Care Group, a sub team that cares for candles and light housekeeping of the altar area, might be the group for you.
